

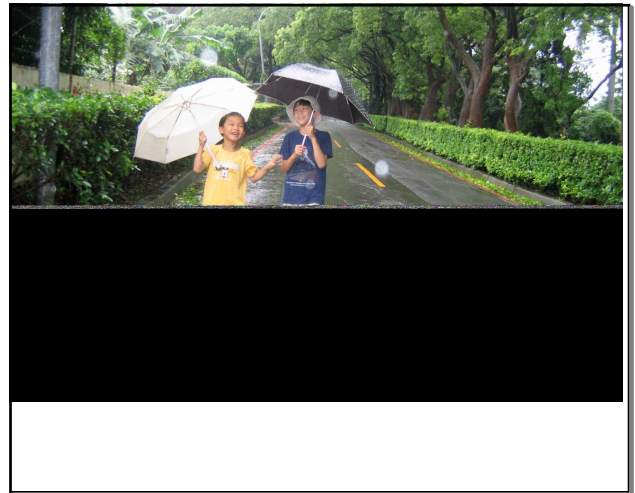

2. What information is missing when you describe weather using only a photograph?

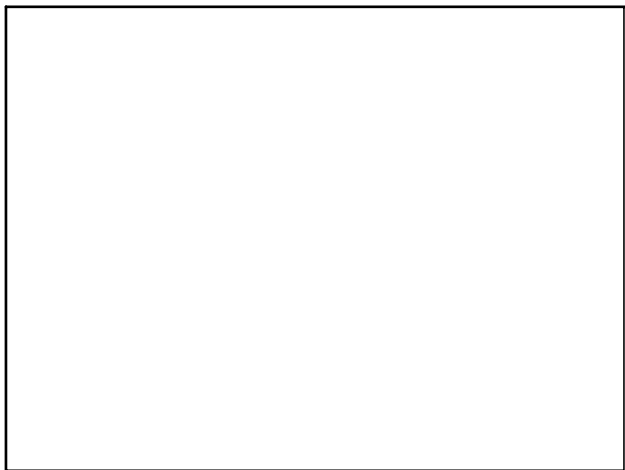
We are missing exact temperature information, how it feels, how windy it is, and how much precipitation or humidity there is.
